

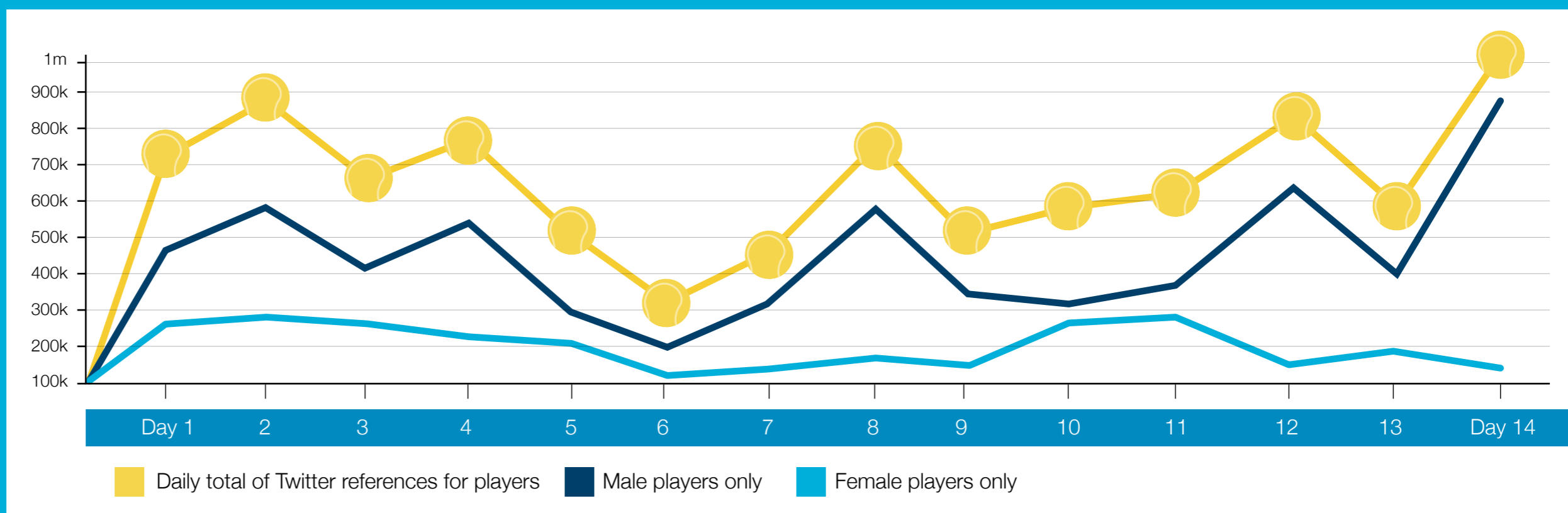

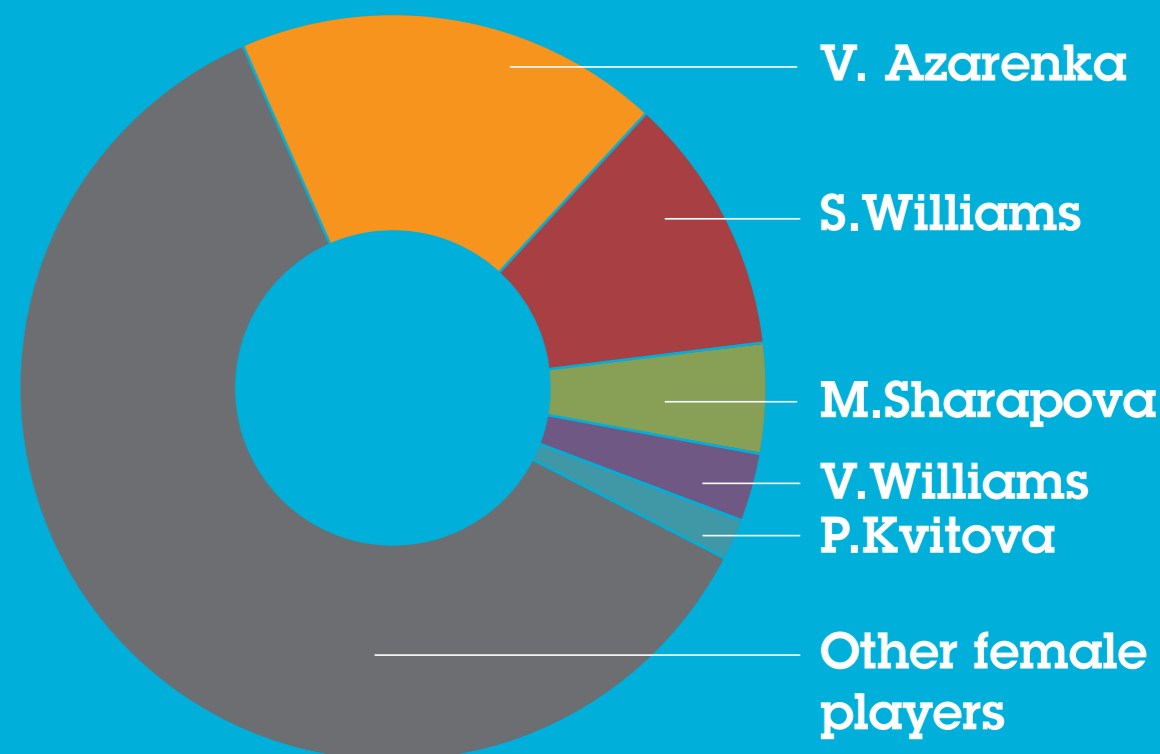
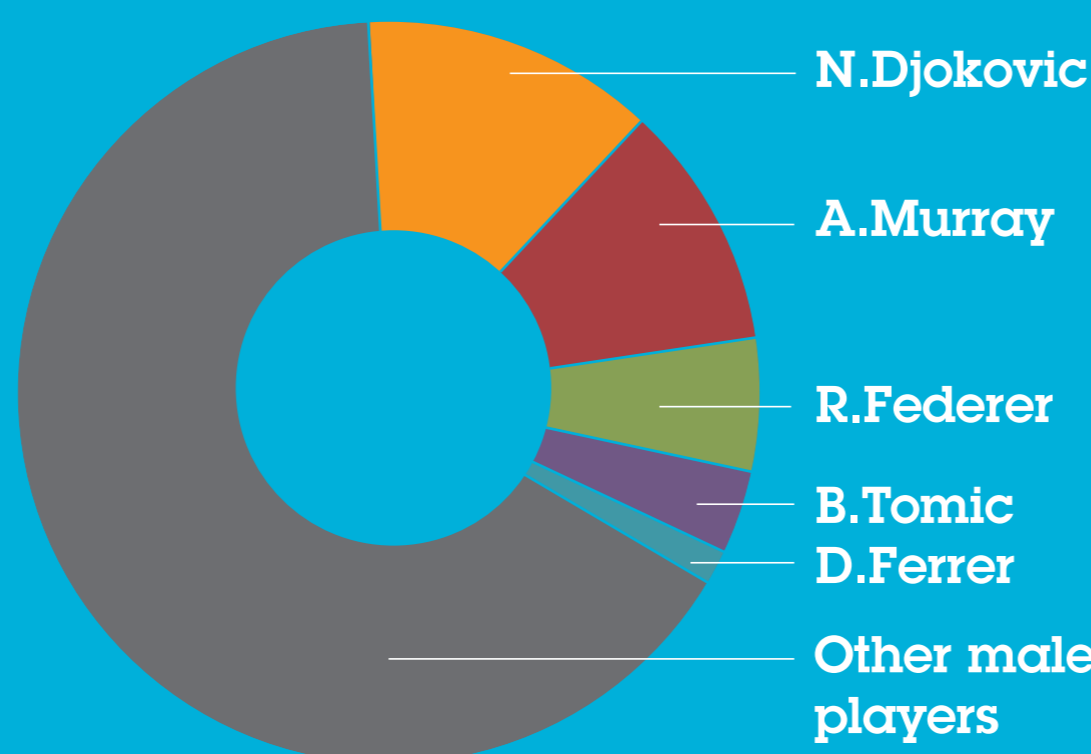

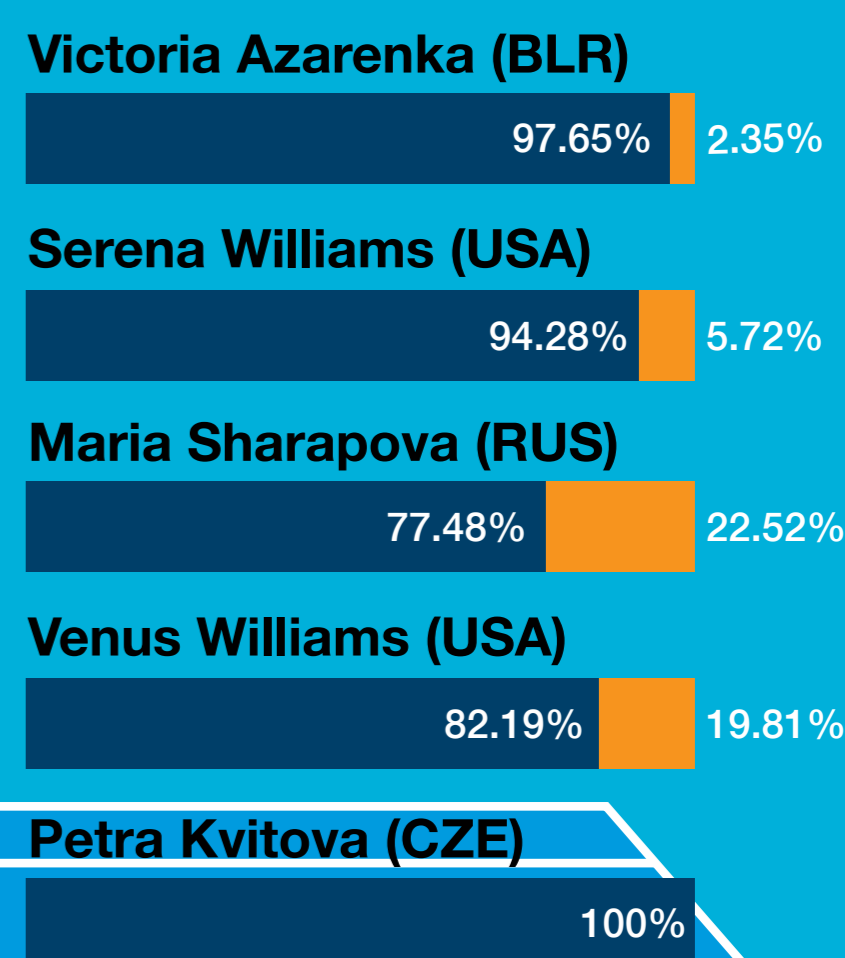
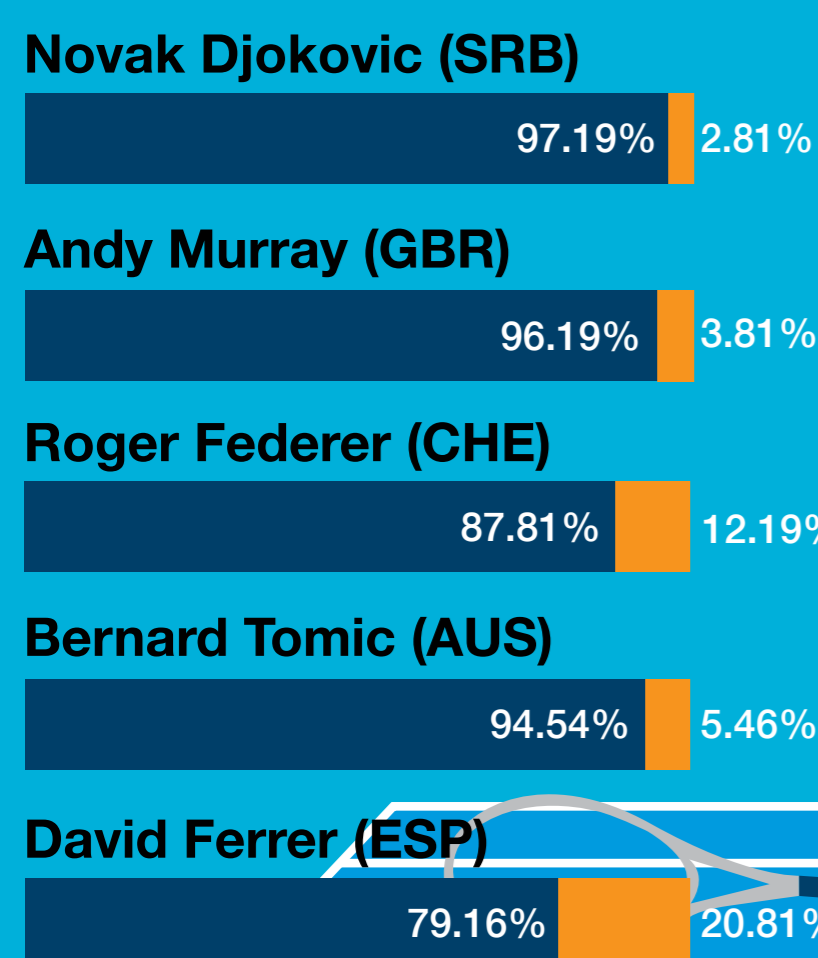

Sentiment breakdown for popular players across social media for the tournament



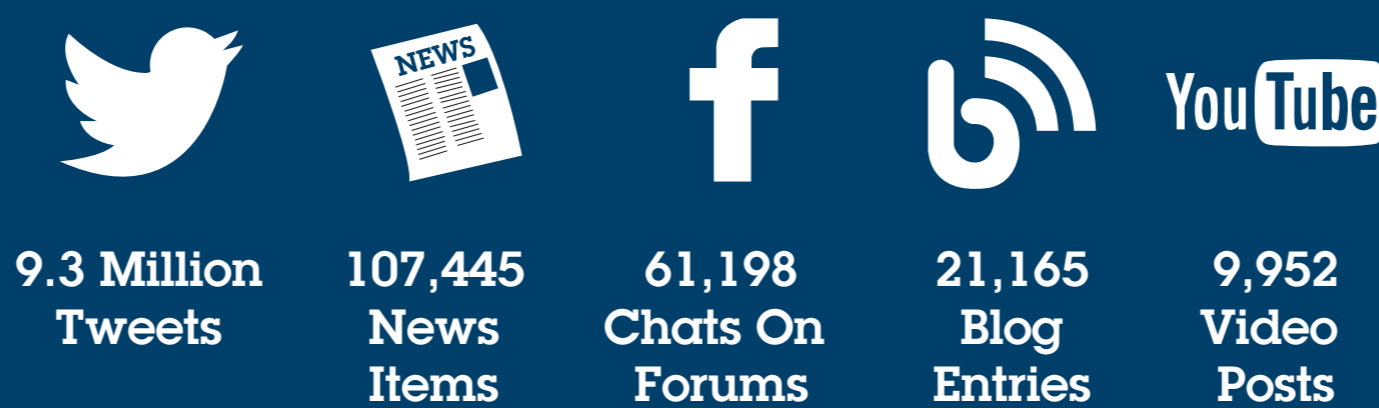
