ADA LOVELACE

Lovelace worked with Charles Babbage on the Analytical Engine, which is considered to be the first computer program.

1843



CLAUDE SHANNON

Known as the 'Father of Information Theory', Shannon quantified information produced by a source to binary digits, 'bits'.

STEVE JOBS STEVE WOZNIAK

Jobs and Wozniak co-founded Apple Inc in 1977, and pioneered the personal computer revolution.

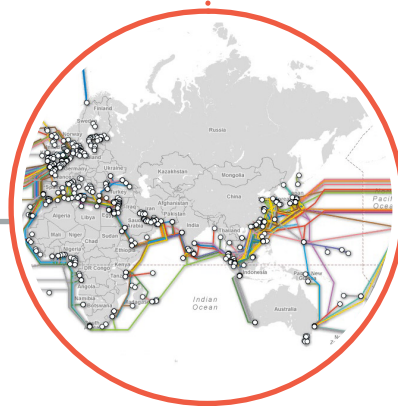
